

Year One – Curriculum Newsletter

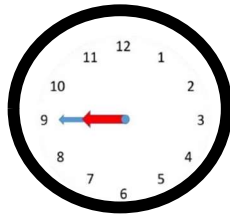
Our Big Question this term is:
