## Things to remember:

- Please ensure your child has their reading book and book bag in school every day. All children have access to paper books and e-books on Oxford Owl. The children need these daily in their Phonics lessons.
- **Year 2 PE lessons** are now **Monday** and **Thursdays**. Children must wear the correct school colours (plain black/blue or white). Otherwise, we will ask them to change into spare uniform. If your child wears earrings, please ensure that they have micropore tape to cover them or a pot to put them into after taking them out.
- Water bottles will be sent home every Friday for washing, please ensure that this is returned every **Monday**. If we have to issue your child a new water bottle you will be charged via our parent pay system.
- 1-minute Maths — this is a free app from White Rose Maths developing maths skills. It is brilliant at supporting children recall facts fluently.
- Home Learning Projects will be put on Class Dojo during the first few weeks of the term, please keep your eye out for this and return any learning to school within the term.



Starting school at the right time is very important! Please ensure your child is in school by 08:45. After 08:55 you will need to take your child into school through the main school office.
