COMPUTING

Current learning: grouping data. Labelling, counting, describing and comparing groups
Children will be using a programme to compare tools, join blocks, make a change and design a project

Key vocabulary: object, label, data, group, features.



HISTORY

Current learning: How has Daventry changed? We will be learning about different types of houses and homes in our local area as well as exploring how the town has changed.

Key vocabulary: Home, House, Detached, Semi-detached, Terraced, Flats, Floors, Rooms, Driveway, Garden, Chimney, Attic/loft, brick, clay, glass, wood, Medieval, Tudor, Georgian, Victorian, modern, features.



DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

Current learning: Can we use information about habitats in design? Design, make and evaluate a house (product) for a small animal or bug (user) to live in (purpose).

Key vocabulary: Habitats, micro-habitats, names of mini-beasts, names of micro-habitats = leaves, soil, twigs, grass, rocks
Cardboard, tubes, sticks, bottles



ENGLISH- WRITING

- Current learning: Little Red Riding Hood - traditional tales/writing a narrative. We will write our own version of a traditional tale.
- Our Trip to the Woods - non-fiction/recount. We will write a recount about our own trip to the woods.
- Make a bug hotel - instructions.
- Poetry

Key vocabulary: fiction, non-fiction, recount, instructions



GEOGRAPHY

Current learning: What can we use to help us find our way around? We will use maps and compasses to help us find our way around. We will create our own maps with a key.

Key vocabulary: map, compass, direction, key, human features, physical features, similarities, differences.



PE

Current learning: This term Mr Nixon will be teaching football fundamentals and class teachers will teach athletics and target games.

Key vocabulary: dribble, kick, throw, receive, pass.



ART

Current learning: Is all art in a frame or on a canvas? We will be looking at the work of other artists and creating our own art.

Key vocabulary: Circles, dots, lines, pattern, observe, thick, thin, narrow, wavy

MATHS

Current learning: Multiplication and division, fractions, position & direction.

Key vocabulary:
Multiply, divide, part, whole, half, quarter, forward, back, left, right, turn.



RE

Current learning: We will be exploring what it means to belong to a faith in various communities including Christians, Muslims and Jewish people.

Key vocabulary:
Faith, community, Judaism, Christianity, belonging, Islam



MUSIC - Wake and Shake / Noodle drumming

Current learning: We will be revisiting body percussion and following rhythm grids and creating our own. In the final half term we will be introduced to noodle drumming and keeping the beat.

Key vocabulary: pulse, beat, fast, slow, rhythm, instruments, sing, perform.



PSHE

Current learning: We are learning about family relationships, friendships, appropriate physical behaviours and identifying adults who can help us.

Key vocabulary: relationships, safe, hand of trust, help, danger, consent



SCIENCE

Current learning: How can we find out about plants around us? We will be looking at plants in our local environment and learning about wild flowers and garden flowers. We will also be exploring our senses.

Key vocabulary: plants, flower, petal, stem, leaf, weed, wild plants, garden plants, evergreen trees, deciduous trees, pollen, pollination. sight, hearing, touch, smell and taste.
