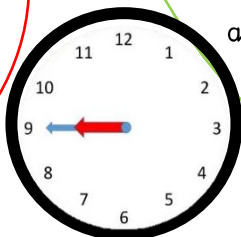
Pre-school starts at 8.45am; please be prompt to ensure your child gets their full learning experience from each session. Learning starts the moment they walk in each day 😊
