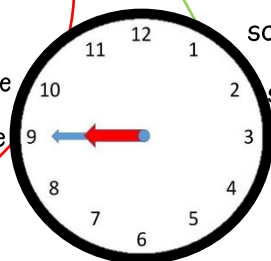
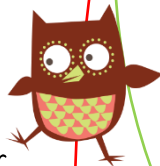

Our Year One Curriculum:

We will soon be sharing a presentation with you, which will provide you with a brief overview of Year 1, what we teach when, any key things within the year to look out for and how you can support your child at home. Please look out for this and let us know if you have any questions. We will share a knowledge organiser with you this week which will outline the learning for each subjects for this term.

Reminders!

- Water bottles **need** to be brought into school on **Monday** and will be sent home on a **Friday**. If we have to issue your child with a new bottle there will be charge of £1.50 via Parent Pay.
