Will it grow?

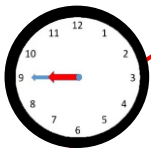
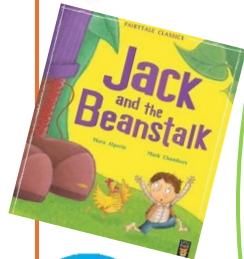


Poppies Curriculum:

In our maths this term we will be digging deeper in the number 1-5, naming 2D and 3D shapes and comparing amounts. Our literacy learning will be Alliteration, oral blending, retelling familiar stories and continuing to develop our rhyming skills,
