Things to remember:

- Please ensure your child has their reading book and book bag in school **every day**. All children have access to paper books. The children need these daily in their Phonics lessons.
- Please can homework books be returned to school every **Thursday** ready for new homework to be set on Fridays.
- **Year 2 PE lessons** are **Tuesday** and **Thursdays**. Children must wear the correct school colours (plain black/blue or white). Otherwise, we will ask them to change into spare uniform. If your child wears earrings, please ensure that they have micropore tape to cover them or a pot to put them into after taking them out.
- Water bottles will be sent home every Friday for washing, please ensure that this is returned every **Monday**.



Starting school at the right time is very important! Please ensure your child is in school by 08:45. After 08:55 you will need to take your child into school through the main school office.
