Reminders!

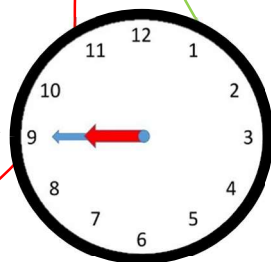
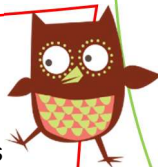
- Water bottles must be brought into school every day. You can leave your child's bottle in the classroom if you wish.
