# Pre-school writing



### **Phonics**

Phase 1 of phonics is focused on. The aim of this is to develop children's listening skills and awareness of sounds.

Phase 1 focuses on the following: Environmental sounds, Instrumental sounds, Body percussion (e.g. clapping and stamping), Rhythm and rhyme, <u>Alliteration</u>, Voice sounds, Oral <u>blending</u> and segmenting (e.g. hearing that d-o-g makes 'dog')

## **Handwriting**

In Pre-school we focus mainly on building strength in the body and in the hands by doing a range of activities which builds on these in order to get children ready to write letter shapes.

Children begin to learn the letter moves: Down, up, push, pull, slide, flick.

#### Sentence Structure

The emphasis in Pre-school is on speech. Children are encouraged to use more complex sentences to link thoughts. They are also supported to use a range of tenses and build up vocabulary that reflects their experiences.

## **Punctuation**
