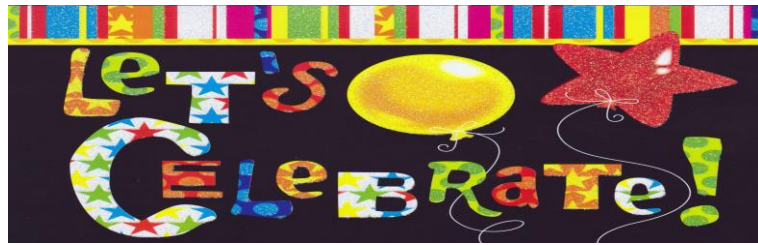
- Children will still be in bubble groups
