## Message from Mrs Gynn

#### End of year arrangements

As the end of this academic approaches (very quickly!), we find ourselves in a very similar position to last year; having to adhere to the restrictions Covid-19 places upon us.

With the confirmation this week that there is no possibility of restrictions lifting before the end of term, we have had to re-think our arrangements. Please see the details below:

#### Year 2 Transition

All of those children transitioning to The Abbey CE Junior School will have a visit from their year 3 teachers on the 12<sup>th</sup> July.

On the 13<sup>th</sup> July, it is transition day. The day will be divided into two group: a morning group and an afternoon group.

\*Bluebells and Dandelions are the morning group. They will go straight to The Abbey to arrive at 9.00 a.m.

They will stay at the school all morning, in their year 3 classroom with their teacher. Please provide them with a packed lunch because they will also eat lunch there.

They will be collected by our staff at 12.30 p.m. and brought back to our school for the afternoon. Please collect from our school at the end of the day

\*Buttercups and Snowdrops are the afternoon group. They will eat lunch at our school and then get walked over to The Abbey by our staff. They will spend all afternoon in their year 3 classroom with their teacher. Please collect your child from The Abbey at 3.00 p.m.

You should drop off or collect from the entrance on Vicar Lane (just by McDonalds).

All of those children transitioning to Falconers Hill Academy will have a visit from their year 3 teachers on the 12<sup>th</sup> July.

At the moment, it is hoped that they will still have a transition day on the  $13^{th}$  July, but I am waiting for confirmation. I will let you know as soon as I can.

#### New Reception children

We are still planning to go ahead with the 'play and stay' sessions, the dates have already been sent out. Please be advised that they will now be hosted outside. If the weather does not allow this, unfortunately, they will be cancelled.

Parents should wear a face mask whilst they are on site.

#### New children joining Poppy class

Again, we ask that parents wear a face mask
throughout the visit.
