Working together to use the parachute, in P.E. this week.


Hope you have a lovely Bank Holiday weekend. School resumes on Tuesday.

We have had to clear cigarette ends from around the school gates. Please help us to keep the site clean by using the bins or taking your rubbish with you.




Everybody did a mile today they just kept on running! Everybody felt so much happier being outdoors.
