Every day is a learning adventure!

We do all that we can to support parents and carers in ensuring that each child's attendance is as good as it can be. There is more work to be done though - as Ofsted noted in their report, 'some pupils miss too much of the school's curriculum because they are absent from school.'

Schools are required to keep detailed records of children's attendance, including any absence from school.

We know that those children who establish good patterns of attendance in the earliest years of schooling, are more likely to continue this pattern as they get older. We also know there is a clear link between good attendance and the outcomes children achieve at the end of their time in school i.e. children whose attendance is higher are more likely to achieve 5 good GCSE results.
