Road Safety Tips



As the days are getting shorter, I thought it would be a good opportunity to talk to your children about road safety and to practise 'Stop, look, listen' as you walk with them.

Other things to tell them:

- Always use a zebra crossing
- Wear something reflective so that you can always be seen.

KNOW THE CODE

One, two, three, safe cross Four, five, six safe cross One, two, three, four, five, six, SAFE CROSS CODE

REMEMBER.

ONE - look for a safe place TWO - don't hurry stop and wait THREE - look all around and listen before you cross the road, remember FOUR - let all the traffic pass you FME – then walking straight across you

SDX - Keep watching, thats the SAFE CROSS CODE

Safe place STOP and WAIT Safe place STOP and WATT Safe ground LOOK AROUND LISTEN for a traffic sound If traffic's coming LET IT PASS Until the road is CLEAR at LAST Then WALKING straight across the road KEEP WATCHING, THATS THE CODE

Please see the dates and share them with friends and family. We would love to welcome everyone.


