Listening to children read





Listening to your children read

at home, or sharing books with them is one of the best things you can do. It helps them to remember letter sounds / helps to develop vocabulary / helps to develop fluency skills / helps to develop imagination.

We run a reading challenge in school. When your child reads 20, 50, 100 times or more at school they put an apple on the display and receive a brand new book. Please help us to award the children by writing in their reading record book when you listen to them


