## Food in school

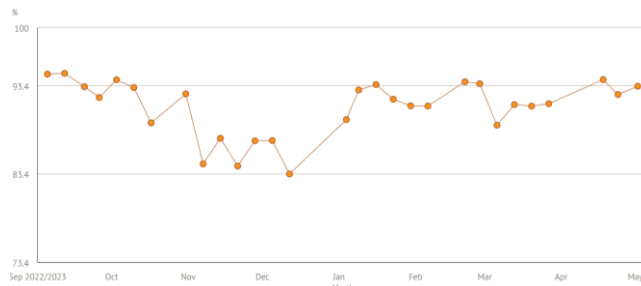
Children should not be bringing food items into their classrooms; breakfast food or sweets.

## This week's book recommendation:

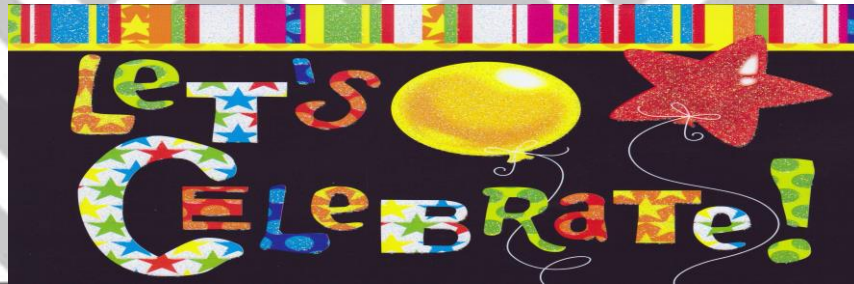
Keeping with the theme of the Coronation, here are two more books for you to enjoy over the Bank Holiday weekend.

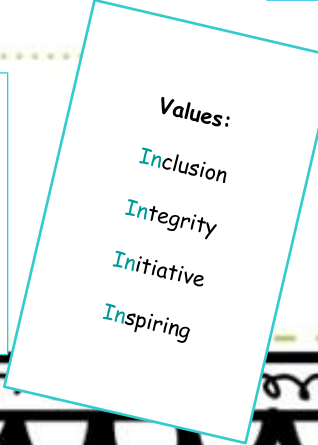
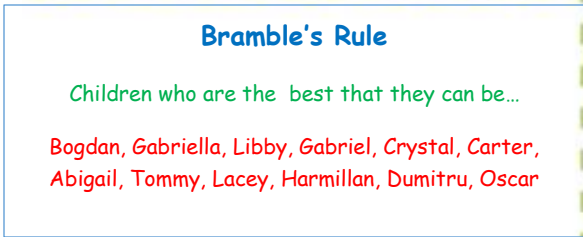
