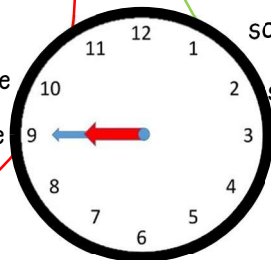
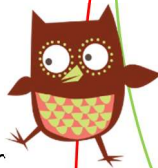

Our Year One Curriculum:
