If a child makes a disclosure:

- Listen and be supportive
- Take the child seriously
- Reassure the child that what's happened isn't their fault
- Let the child guide the conversation
- Explain what you need to do next, and why – be clear about the steps that will be taken
- -Ask open questions
- -Write up on MyConcern
- -Speak with a DSL

- -These people will then contact the designated officer (LADO)
